Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	For <a href="#">network providers</a> \$3,000 individual / \$6,000 family; for <a href="#">out-of-network providers</a> \$9,000 individual / \$18,000 family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Yes. In-network <a href="#">preventive care</a> , primary care, <a href="#">specialist</a> , <a href="#">urgent care</a> , virtual care visits, outpatient mental health and chemical dependency, outpatient diagnostic testing, outpatient <a href="#">rehabilitation</a> and <a href="#">habilitation</a> , and children's vision care as well as most in and out of network prescription medications are covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> .	This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. What is the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> for this <a href="#">plan</a> ?	For <a href="#">network providers</a> \$8,550 individual / \$17,100 family; for <a href="#">out-of-network providers</a> \$25,650 individual / \$51,300 family.	The <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <a href="#">plan</a> , they have to meet their own <a href="#">out-of-pocket limits</a> until the overall family <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> has been met.
What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> ?	<a href="#">Premiums</a> , <a href="#">balance-billing</a> charges, expenses incurred due to brand substitution and health care this <a href="#">plan</a> doesn't cover. Will you pay less if you use a <a href="#">network provider</a> ?	Yes.
